### **Dr. James Broomall, Director, George Tyler Moore Center for the Study of the Civil War**

Dr. James Broomall will speak about the current programs at the George Tyler Moore Center for the Study of the Civil War, a unit of Shepherd University. Dr. Broomall is Director of the Center and an Assistant Professor of History at Shepherd. He earned his Ph.D. from the University of Florida in 2011 and his BA from the University of Delaware. He is completing a study of the C&O Canal during the Civil War for the National Park Service and the Organization of American Historians, and in 2016, he will co-publish *Rethinking American Emancipation: Legacies of Slavery and the Quest for Black Freedom*.
