Today's Presentation

This morning's program will be presented by Ensign Miles Kushnereit, who will give an Overview of Navy Sea Cadets Program. The program exposes its cadets ages 13 yrs through high school graduation to the full rigors of a military training program. Cadets are required to attend a mandatory 2 wk recruit training camp. After the camp, the cadets are eligible to participate in a variety of advanced training sessions. These sessions expose cadets to seamanship & seagoing objects, and foster an appreciation of U. S. naval history. Ensign Kushnereit is the Instructor of the W. V. Division of the Navy Sea Cadets Corps, which is located in Charleston.

Ensign Kushnereit graduated from a Richmond, VA, high school, where he was enrolled in the Navy Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps. He moved to the Eastern Panhandle in 2012, where he currently works in retail as a Department Manager. Once a month he travels to Charleston to instruct the Navy Sea Cadets corps located there. He is one of the youngest instructors/commanding officers in the Program.
