This morning, Ms. Chad Conant will direct a performance of the 27-member, award-winning Shepherdstown Middle School Jazz Band. This concert is a highlight of the Rotary program year.

Ms. Conant was a September, 2015, recipient of the Paul Harris Fellow award from our Club, in recognition of her "service above self" to the student musicians of the Middle School Jazz Band. Additionally, she received the November, 2013, Vocational Service Award from our Club.

Ms. Conant received her B. A. from Middlebury College, & a Master's degree in Music, & a teaching certificate, from Shepherd University. She initially taught at elementary schools in Jefferson Co. & in Shepherdstown. Since joining Shepherdstown Middle School, the school's Concert & Jazz bands have excelled & received numerous honors.

Among her personal honors, Ms. Conant received the West Virginia Band Director of the Year Award in 2012, & the Shepherdstown Middle School Teacher of the Year Award in 2013.
