## Today's Presentation

This morning Ms. Pam Wagoner, of the Rotary Club of Martinsburg, & Assistant Governor for Rotary Area 16, will speak about the West Virginia Relief Projects in which Rotarians participated this past winter. On November, 27, 2016, four local Rotary Clubs teamed up with Mennonite Disaster Services to help with the construction of three homes that were destroyed in the historic June, 2016, flooding of southern WV. Eleven Rotarians & one non-Rotarian worked a total of 204 man-hours on this project. The volunteers met one of the recipient families, & received a video of a mother with a new baby girl moving into a newly-constructed house about 2 weeks after the volunteers returned.

Ms. Wagoner is a native of Jefferson County. She grew up working in her father's landscaping business & learned to love and appreciate plants. After graduation she worked for a Martinsburg florist for 17 years & learned the floral business. She opened her own floral business in 1998 & has four employees.

In addition to her Rotary leadership, Ms. Wagoner serves on the board of C-CAP Loaves & Fishes, and is active with the Boy Scouts & Girl Scouts. In recognition of her service to the youth of Berkeley County, Ms. Wagoner will receive the 2017 Distinguished Citizen of Berkeley County award on March 14 from the Potomac District, Shenandoah Area Council, Boy Scouts of America.
